## Loss of California College Promise Grant Appeal (formerly Board of Governors Fee Waiver)

Loss of Eligibility for the California College Promise Grant (CCPG) Per Title 5, § 58621, students who are eligible for the CCPG may lose their eligibility if they fail to sustain a GPA of 2.0 or higher and complete more than 50% of their coursework. Any combination of two consecutive primary terms (Fall & Spring) of academic or progress probation will result in loss of fee waiver eligibility. Foster youth and former foster youth (age 24 years and younger) are not subject to the loss of the CCPG under these regulations. **Submit appeal & required documentation to the nearest location listed above or email: [admissions@cos.edu](mailto:admissions@cos.edu).**
